Rev. Hill pastors LifeChurch Riverside, an Evangelical Covenant Church based in Detroit, MI, that was planted in 2020 as an online faith community during the global pandemic. LifeChurch Riverside now meets weekly at the Marygrove campus in Detroit where they are engaged in mission and friendship to local children as well as families who are currently without a permanent address, and to people in the Democratic Republic of Congo and Liberia. On a 2018 trip to Israel Rev. Hill served as a co-leader with Rev. Elaine Thomas of Hartford Memorial Baptist Church of a group of 18 called the “Women of Valor Tour”. Rev. Hill previously served as the Associate Pastor of Plymouth United Church of Christ for 19 years. She currently serves on the President’s Advisory Council at Our Daily Bread Publishing and on the Black Church in Detroit Advisory Committee for Detroit Public Television.

Rev. Hill graduated from Harvard University, Howard University Law School, and McCormick Theological Seminary. Her devotions have appeared in several publications of Our Daily Bread Publishing. Together with co-author Diane Reeder, Rev. Hill wrote *Cloud of Women: The Powerful Connection Between Black Women and Women of the Bible* published by Our Daily Bread. Rev. Hill is a contributing writer to the book *Woman to Woman: African American Voices on Faith, Resilience and Joy* also published by Our Daily Bread. Rev.
