Title: Are You in a Dead Season?

Description: "Don't focus on your troubles—tell them, "This is what the Lord God says about you."

1. Foundation Scriptures & Reflection:

Speak God's Word to dry places. (Ezekiel 37:1-9)

Joy and strength are found in God, even in famine. (Habakkuk 3:17-19)

2. Recognize Your Season:

Key Thought: You must acknowledge where you are in order to speak to where you want to be.

Activity: Write what feels dry or lifeless on an index card

3. Identity & Authority in Christ:

Key Thought: You must speak life because you are God's child and you have authority.

Biblical Truths:

Proclaim your completeness in Him (Colossians 2:10)

Testify that you are an overcomer (1 John 5:4-5 )

Declare that you are a co-heir with Christ (Romans 8:17)

Shout that you are the righteousness of God in Christ! (2 Corinthians 5:21)

4. Speak Life:

Key Thought: You must speak the Word of the Lord in those dry places.

Key Question: What is preventing you from speaking?

Biblical Truths:

Believe & Declare by Faith (2 Corinthians 4:13, Hebrews 11:1)

Speak Good - Not Fear (1 Peter 3:10; Proverbs 18:21)

Activate the power of God's Word (Hebrews 4:12)

5. Stay Planted. Stay Watered. Stay Joyful. Stay in Peace.

Key Thought: You must remain rooted in God's Word, to be refreshed by His Spirit even in lack.

Biblical Truths:

Stay Planted: Meditate on His Word. (Psalms 1:2-3)

Stay Watered: Those planted by water will bear fruit (Jeremiah 17:7-8)

Stay Joyful: Rejoice in the Lord always. (Philippians 4:4-7)

Stay in Peace: Keep your mind stayed on Him. (Isaiah 26:3)
